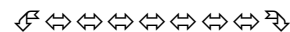

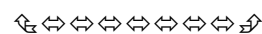

Bylaw Change and Election of Officers

According to our bylaws, the membership must be advised 30-days in advance of any proposed bylaw change as well the election of officers. Our Bylaws Chairman Carolyn Hayes has submitted this change:

The following amendment to Article IV Officers, Section 1, of the Heartland Chapter Bylaws is submitted to the membership by the Executive Board and will be voted on at the November 12 dance prior to the election of officers for the coming year.

Current Wording

The officers of the Chapter shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and five Directors. These officers shall be elected

Proposed Wording

The officers of the Chapter shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and a minimum of one and a maximum of five Directors. These officers shall be elected

The Executive Board and Nominating Committee unanimously encourage the membership to adopt this proposed amendment. Over the past few years, it has become increasingly more difficult to find members who are willing to serve on the Executive Board. This amendment will allow flexibility in the number of directors required to serve in officer positions.

If the above amendment passes, then the following amendment to Article VI, The Executive Board, Section 2, will be voted upon.

Current Wording

Six of the nine officer positions shall constitute a quorum. However, actions of the Executive Board shall require an assenting vote of not less than a majority of the entire Executive Board.

Proposed Wording

Two-thirds of the officer positions shall constitute a quorum. However, actions of the Executive Board shall require an assenting vote of not less than a majority of the entire Executive Board.

This change will be necessary to accommodate the possibility of fewer than nine officer positions on the Executive Board.

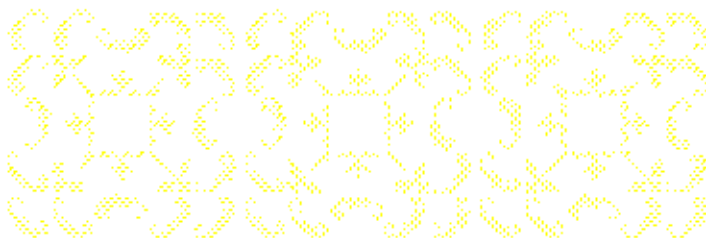
